



Why are we doing this project?

VDOT has identified the need to improve the accessibility and safety for pedestrians and increase the vehicular capacity of the intersection.

What is the location of the project?

The project encompasses the intersection of Routes 1 (N. Washington Highway) and 54 (England Street) in the Town of Ashland.

What are the improvements?

The project will include adding turn lanes and through lanes, making improvements to the existing signals and adding pedestrian accommodations; including sidewalks, crosswalks and pedestrian signals.

When will the project be constructed?

Construction is expected to begin in February 2015 and will last until summer of 2016.

How much will the project cost?

The total project cost estimate is \$6.6 million. This includes the estimated price for design, right of way acquisition and construction.

What are the anticipated traffic impacts?

Construction will take place during overnight hours and require intermittent lane closures.
