TRAFFIC SWITCH COMING AT MULATTO RUN BRIDGE PROJECT *Motorists should be alert for new traffic pattern, use caution through work zone*

CULPEPER — Motorists are advised that a traffic switch is planned for late next week on Route 231 (North Blue Ridge Turnpike) in Madison County, where work will begin on the southbound side of the Mulatto Run bridge.

On Thursday, Aug. 20, weather permitting, the Virginia Department of Transportation will switch traffic to the recently reconstructed northbound lane, where workers are completing roadway paving and guardrail installation. The temporary traffic signal will remain in place to control two-way traffic.

Motorists are asked to be mindful of the change in traffic pattern and continue to obey the 25 mph speed limit through the work zone.

In October 2014, VDOT contractor Allegheny Construction Co. of Roanoke began replacement of the 83-year-old Mulatto Run bridge, located four miles north of the town of Madison. The \$3.59 million construction project has a completion date of Dec. 18.
