

Route 3 Widening Project—Culpeper

Activity is underway to widen the two-lane section of Route 3 in Culpeper County for approximately five miles from Stevensburg to Lignum. This is the final section of Route 3 in Culpeper County to be widened to four lanes and will result in a four-lane highway between Culpeper and Fredericksburg, enhancing safety for the traveling public.

VDOT has awarded a \$23.6 million contract to Branch Highways, Inc., a Virginia company, which is teaming with JMT, a design company with an office in Richmond, to complete the project by May 2017. Branch will build a new two-lane road and rehabilitate the existing two-lane highway, and is also responsible for right of way acquisition, utility relocation, and storm drainage.
