Welcome to the Virginia Department of Transportation's (VDOT) citizen information meeting on the proposal to widen Route 711 (Huguenot Trail) from two lanes to four lanes between Route 288 and the Powhatan/Chesterfield County line.

Bikes lanes would be added on both sides of Route 711 and a sidewalk would be added on the south side as part of this project.

The project would also replace the bridge on Bernard's Creek.

This public information meeting is being held to provide an opportunity for individuals or organizations to give VDOT comments and/or suggestions on the proposed project. VDOT strives to ensure that all members of the community have the opportunity to participate in public decisions on transportation projects and programs affecting them.



Project Overview



Total anticipated cost - \$23 million

Purpose - Widen Route 711 (Huguenot Trail) from two lanes to four lanes. Replace the bridge on Bernard's Creek.

Anticipated start- February 2016

Anticipated completion- February 2018

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The purpose and need of the project is improve safety and mitigate congestion by widening Route 711 (Huguenot Trail) from two lanes to four lanes between Route 288 and the Powhatan/Chesterfield County line and to replace the bridge over Bernard's Creek.

Bicycle and pedestrian access will be improved by adding bike lanes and sidewalks.
