



**I-64 Hampton Roads Express Lanes Segment 4c
City of Hampton
Virtual and In-Person Design Public Hearing**

Find out about the proposed project to widen I-64 and rehabilitate the existing lanes with an additional 12-foot-wide travel lane in each direction from 0.139 mile east of LaSalle Avenue to 0.379 mile east of Settlers Landing Road in the City of Hampton. The three existing eastbound and westbound general purpose (GP) lanes will be converted into two express lanes and two GP lanes, totaling four lanes in each direction. This will extend the full roadway section of the Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel Expansion project to the west for 2.4 miles. This section of the interstate includes six mainline bridges, one pedestrian underpass and one triple 48-inch reinforced concrete pipe section carrying Brights Creek beneath I-64. The eastbound Hampton River bridges will be replaced and the westbound Hampton River Bridge will be widened and rehabilitated. The remaining bridges within the project limits will be widened and/or rehabilitated. This project will involve a change and/or break in limited access control.

Two public hearings will be offered, one virtually and one in-person. VDOT representatives will share project information and be present to answer questions. The presentation will be available for review throughout the comment period. During the in-person hearing, VDOT will follow all COVID-19 precautions to ensure the health and safety of attendees. Project plans and the draft environmental document in the form of a Categorical Exclusion is available on the project website included above and can be viewed after the public hearing. In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Pat 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register for Historic Places will be provided in the project's environmental documentation.
