Find out about plans to install left and right turn lanes on Route 311 at Route 58 in Pittsylvania County. During construction, traffic will be maintained in either direction. The project limits are from 0.13 miles west of Route 311 to 0.013 miles east of Route 311. The hearing will be held in an "open house" format and VDOT representatives will be present to answer questions.
