



Allegheny Street Bridge over Big Creek in Richlands Bridge Rehabilitation Project

Find out about the proposed plans to repair the Allegheny Street Bridge over Big Creek in the Town of Richlands. During the project, which is anticipated to take approximately 6 months, there will be a 2-3 week timeframe where the bridge is closed.

Review the project information and National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Bristol District Office located at 870 Bonham Road in Bristol, 276-669-6151, 1-800-FOR-ROAD, TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. David Lively, VDOT Project Manager, 870 Bonham Road, Bristol, VA 24201, on or prior to **November 7, 2019**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
