



Old Route 19/460 Tazewell County Intent to Abandon

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) intends to abandon a portion of Old Route 19/460 surplus right of way beginning 0.82 mile east of Route 639 and extending east approximately 0.13 mile.

Anyone who wishes to comment about the intended abandonment can do so from 10 a.m. until 12 p.m. on Monday, February 14, 2010 at VDOT's Lebanon Residency located at 1067 Fincastle Road in Lebanon. Written comments must be received no later than 5 p.m. on February 14. Please call 1-800-FOR-ROAD with any questions.

This matter will be considered at a Commonwealth Transportation Board meeting following the close of the comment period. As prescribed by §33.1-145 of the Code of Virginia, the board is required to make a formal resolution ordering the abandonment of the road.
