



Route 687 (Alean Road) Franklin County Bridge Replacement Project

Find out about the proposed plans to replace the Route 687 (Alean Road) bridge over Maggodee Creek in Franklin County. The project will involve removing the existing one-lane structure and building a new, one-lane, three-span truss bridge.

Environmental documents in the form of a Categorical Exclusion and Section 4(f) Evaluation are being developed and will be available for review within 45 days of the expiration date of this notice. In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is available and will also be provided in the environmental documentation.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Richard Caywood, P.E., Virginia Department of Transportation, P.O. Box 7031, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to Tuesday, **February 8, 2011**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
