**Come see** about the proposed replacement of the Route 65 bridge over Big Branch in Scott County with a box culvert. The bridge is located near the intersection of Route 648. During approximately three days of the project, traffic will be controlled by flaggers 24-hours-a-day and there will be a temporary traffic diversion in place adjacent to the bridge.

**Review** the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a programmatic categorical exclusion at the public hearing or at VDOT's Bristol District Office located at 870 Bonham Road in Bristol, 276-669-6151, 1-800-FOR-ROAD, TTY/TDD 711. Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above addresses and will be available at the public hearing.
