**Find out** about the proposed improvements along a 0.4260-mile section of Route 58/23 in the Gate City area of Scott County, near the intersection of Route 58/619 (Filter Plant Ford). The proposed project will enhance safety by improving drainage, closing six crossovers to reduce crashes, adding a park and ride lot, relocating the intersection of Routes 58 and 619, and adding a right turn lane and left turn lanes at the new intersection location.

**Review** the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a programmatic categorical exclusion at the public hearing or at VDOT's Bristol District Office located at 870 Bonham Road in Bristol, 276-669-6151, 800-352-1730, or TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to assure the appropriate personnel are available to answer your questions.

Property impact information, relocation assistance policies, and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above addresses and will be available at the public hearing.
