OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES ON I-64 FOR BRIDGE REPAIRS *Exit 118 westbound ramp to U.S. 29 south closed 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., follow detour route*

CULPEPER — A contractor with the Virginia Department of Transportation will repair the deck of the Interstate 64 westbound bridge over U.S. 29 beginning at 9 p.m. tonight. During the work one westbound lane will be closed, as will the ramp to U.S. 29 south.

Detour signs will direct traffic intending to take the U.S. 29 south exit ramp onto U.S. 29 north to Fontaine Avenue, where motorists may cross the overpass and reenter U.S. 29 southbound.

The bridge deck repair will involve removing deteriorating concrete and replacing those areas with fresh concrete. Previous patches have not held up, necessitating the more extensive repairs.

The work will require similar overnight lane closures and detours this week between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. the following morning. Motorists traveling in that area should expect lane closures and a detour around the work zone. Drivers should be alert as they approach the work areas and watch for workers and equipment near the open travel lanes.
