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## **FULL RAMP CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR ROUTE 199 RAMP WIDENING PROJECT**

*Daytime closures to occur on Route 199 on- and off-ramps starting Friday, April 15*

**JAMES CITY COUNTY-** Full ramp closures are scheduled for the Route 199 westbound off-ramp to Richmond Road (U.S. Route 60) and the Richmond Road on-ramp to Route 199 west starting Friday, April 15, 2016, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. as part of a project to widen the Route 199 westbound off-ramp to mitigate congestion. The weekday daytime ramp closures will continue on Monday, April 18 through Thursday, April 21, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for milling and asphalt overlay of the travel lanes and installation of traffic loops. Signs will be in place to alert motorists to the ramp closures and detour.

During the Route 199 westbound off-ramp closure, traffic will be detoured as follows:

**Route 199 westbound traffic:** Traffic will continue westbound on Route 199 to the Mooretown Road (Route 603) west exit, continue under the overpass, and then use the ramp to Route 199 east to the Route 60 exit.

During the Richmond Road to Route 199 West on-ramp closure, traffic will be detoured as follows:

**Route 60 westbound traffic:** Turn right on Lightfoot Road (Route 646) to Mooretown Road (Route 603) and back to the westbound on-ramp to Route 199.

**Route 60 eastbound traffic:** Turn left on Lightfoot Road (Route 646), right on Mooretown Road (Route 603), and back to the westbound on-ramp to Route 199.

**Centerville Road (Route 614) traffic:** Turn left on Richmond Road (Route 60), turn right on Lightfoot Road (Route 646), turn right on Mooretown Road (Route 603), and back to the westbound on-ramp to Route 199.
