HAMPTON ROADS WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES REPORT

For the week of July 22, 2016 through July 29, 2016

- **I-64 Widening Project, Newport News/York County:** Single-lane closures eastbound and westbound July 24-28 as early as 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning. All work will take place between Jefferson Avenue and Lee Hall, and one lane will remain open to traffic at all times. - **Elizabeth River Tunnels/Martin Luther King, Jr. Freeway:** Please check [Elizabeth River Tunnels](http://www.ElizabethRiverTunnels.com) website for the latest closure and detour information regarding the Downtown Tunnel, Midtown Tunnel and the MLK Freeway.
- **I-564 Intermodal Connector, Norfolk:** Please check <http://www.i564intermodal.com/> for the latest closure/detour information.
- **Terminal Boulevard Resurfacing, Norfolk:** Full weeknight/weekend closures eastbound as follows:
 - Weekend of July 22-25: Eastbound full closure from Friday at 8 p.m. until Monday at 5 a.m.
- **Military Highway Continuous Flow Intersection, Norfolk:** Please check www.MilitaryCFI.com for the latest closure/detour information.
- **I-64 Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel:** Single-lane closures and alternating lane closures eastbound and westbound. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - Eastbound July 24-28 from 9 p.m. until as late as 4:30 a.m. the following morning.
 - Westbound July 26-28 from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
- **I-664 Monitor-Merrimac Memorial Bridge-Tunnel:** Alternating lane closures northbound and single-lane closures southbound as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:

- Northbound/ Southbound July 26-28 from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m.
 - Southbound July 27 from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
- **I-64 High Rise Bridge:** Single-lane closures as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - Westbound July 25-28 from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
 - **I-564 Eastbound/Westbound, Norfolk:** Daytime and night-time single-lane closures as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - I-564 Eastbound July 25-28 from 7 p.m. until 4 a.m. between Terminal Boulevard and Norfolk Naval Station Gate 3A & 3.
 - **I-664 Northbound/Southbound, Suffolk:** Intermittent stoppages northbound and southbound July 17 from 12 a.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning. Traffic stoppages will last up to 20 minutes at a time just past the Hampton Roads overpass.
 - **I-64 Eastbound, Hampton:** Single-lane closures eastbound July 20-25 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning from Magruder Boulevard to Mercury Boulevard. One lane will remain open at all times. Also, three ramps will be closed as follows:
 - The I-64 eastbound off-ramp to Mercury Boulevard north will be closed July 24-25 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
 - The I-64 eastbound off-ramp to Mercury Boulevard south will be closed July 25-26 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
 - The on-ramp from Mercury Boulevard south to I-64 eastbound will be closed July 26-28, and July 31 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
 - **I-64 Eastbound, James City County/York County:** Alternating lane closures eastbound July 25-28 from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning between VA-607 Croaker and Lightfoot. One lane will remain open at all times.
 - **I-64 Eastbound/Westbound, York County:** Single-lane closures eastbound July 25-28 from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning between Camp Peary and West Queens Drive Overpass. One lane will remain open at all times.
 - **I-264 Westbound, Norfolk:** Single-lane closures eastbound July 25-28 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning at City Hall Avenue. One lane will remain open at all times.
 - **Route 644 (Turner Drive) Eastbound/Westbound, Isle of Wight County:** Alternating lane closures eastbound and westbound July 25-30 from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. One lane will remain open at all times.
 - **Route 301 Sussex Drive, Greensville County:** Consecutive left northbound lane closure for bridge replacement June 23 through late summer on Route 301.

- **Route 680 over Stallings Creek, Isle of Wight County:** Full consecutive closure on Route 680 over Stallings Creek for bridge replacement May 16 through June 2017.
- **Route 621 over Passenger Swamp, Isle of Wight County:** Full consecutive closure on Route 621 over Passenger Swamp for bridge replacement June 28 through June 2017.
- **George Washington Memorial Highway (Route 17), York County:** Crews are widening the road between Route 630 (Wolf Trap Road) and Route 706 (Hampton Highway). Daytime single-lane closures, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and weeknight single-lane closures, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Expect traffic shifts and delays.
