JAMESTOWN-SCOTLAND FERRY SYSTEM TO RUN AT REDUCED CAPACITY

SURRY– The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) advises Jamestown-Scotland Ferry motorists that the ferry *Williamsburg* will remain out-of-service due to an unexpected delay in repairs. The *Pocahontas*, *Surry* and *Virginia* vessels will continue to ferry motorists across the James River using the normal ferry schedule.

Operations will be diminished by approximately 30 vehicles an hour on Friday, May 27, through Monday, May 30, from 2 p.m. until 9 p.m. Motorists are advised to please plan accordingly.
