## **MILITARY HIGHWAY LANE REDUCTION TO END TOMORROW**

*Crews complete railroad crossing replacement ahead of schedule*

**NORFOLK-** The temporary lane reduction on Military Highway between Robin Hood Road and Northampton Boulevard will end on Wednesday, August 17, a week and a half ahead of schedule. Military Highway will reopen to two lanes in each direction by 5 a.m. Crews have completed the railroad crossing replacement necessary for the Military Highway Continuous Flow Intersection (CFI) project.

Traffic will be intermittently stopped tonight, Tuesday, August 16, at the railroad crossing on Military Highway between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. to prepare for the traffic switch back to the regular roadway. Work is dependent on weather and unexpected delays.

Construction on the Military Highway CFI Project began this month. The \$59.8 million project combines the addition of new lanes, new signals and a new continuous flow intersection that will increase capacity in this important corridor. Two lanes in each direction will remain open during peak travel times throughout project construction.
