PORTION OF ROUTE 602 TO CLOSE FOR A BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN GREENSVILLE COUNTY

Closure with signed detour to begin as early as Aug. 15

GREENSVILLE COUNTY – Starting as early as Aug. 15, Route 602 (Quarrel Road) will be closed to through traffic in both directions between Route 603 (Macedonia Road) and Route 601 (Hells Island Road) in Greensville County for a bridge superstructure replacement project. Access will be maintained to all existing private property entrances within this corridor.

During this closure, crews with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will be replacing the superstructure of the bridge over Quarrel Creek, which includes replacing the beams, deck and rails.

This work is expected to continue through fall 2022. All construction work is dependent upon weather conditions, and the schedule is subject to change. Signed detours will be in place directing traffic through Greensville and Brunswick counties as follows:

Motorists traveling Route 602 east:

- Turn right on Route 627 (Brink Road);
- Turn right on Route 601 (Hells Island Road); and
- Turn right on Route 602 (Quarrel Road).

Motorists traveling Route 602 west:

- Turn left on Route 601 (Hells Island Road);
- Turn left on Route 627 (Brink Road); and
- Turn left on Route 602 (Quarrel Road).

Route 602 (Quarrel Road) will be closed to through traffic in both directions starting as early as Aug. 15.
