JAMESTOWN-SCOTLAND FERRY CHANGES TO SUMMER HOURS

Summer schedule starts May 27

SURRY COUNTY – The Jamestown-Scotland Ferry (JSF), operated by The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), will begin following the [summer operating schedule](#) starting at noon, Friday, May 27.

The [summer operating schedule](#) continues through Monday, Sept. 5 and helps to accommodate the anticipated increase in ferry passengers during the summer travel season. At all other times, the Jamestown-Scotland Ferry will follow the [fall/winter/spring operating schedule](#).

The JSF transports motorists across the James River from Scotland to Jamestown in both directions 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, including major holidays, and is a free service. There are four ferries and one of the largest ferries can hold up to 70 vehicles. Once on board, the trip is approximately 20 minutes.
