
CLEMENT TOWN ROAD (ROUTE 681) TO CLOSE FOR BRIDGE REPAIR WORK IN POWHATAN

Structure is located over the Appomattox River

POWHATAN – Beginning Monday, September 14, Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) crews will close Clement Town Road (Route 681) over the Appomattox River for bridge repair work. Weather permitting, the road is expected to reopen in spring 2021.

During work, the following detour route will be in place:

- **Clement Town Rd. (Rt. 681) north** – Take Genito Rd. (Rt. 616) east to Royalton Rd./Giles Bridge Rd. (Rt. 609) north to Old Buckingham Rd. (Rt. 13) west back to Clement Town Rd.
- **Clement Town Rd. (Rt. 681) south** – Take Old Buckingham Rd. (Rt. 13) east to Giles Bridge Rd./Royalton Rd. (Rt. 609) south to Genito Rd. (Rt. 616) west back to Clement Town Rd.
