EXPECT TRAFFIC IMPACTS ON COURTHOUSE ROAD (ROUTE 155) IN NEW KENT COUNTY FOR PAVING

Drivers advised to stay alert for alternating lane closures, flagging operations

NEW KENT, Va. – Starting Wednesday, March 23, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will be conducting long-term, weekday paving operations on Courthouse Road (Route 155) north and south in New Kent County, between New Kent Highway (Route 249) and Pocahontas Trail (Route 60).

Work will be scheduled each week for 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The project is expected to be complete in October.

Drivers are urged to remain alert within the work zone and expect alternating lane closures and flagging operations in the area.
