**SECTION OF I-95 NORTHBOUND CLOSED AT ROUTE 288 IN CHESTERFIELD
UNTIL AT LEAST FRIDAY AT 8 A.M.**

Drivers are encouraged to use alternate routes

CHESTERFIELD, Va. – The left and center lanes of Interstate 95 northbound are closed near Route 288 (mile marker 62) in Chesterfield County for emergency repairs. The right lane remains open. Depending on the weather, the goal is for all lanes to reopen by 8 a.m. Friday morning. Motorists should expect delays and use alternate routes when possible.

Last night's heavy rainfall caused a quarter-mile section of the pavement to break down and become unsafe for travel. The Chester area received 2.6 inches of rain during the past 48 hours, according to the National Weather Service.
