SECTION OF BEATTIES MILL ROAD (ROUTE 634) TO CLOSE FOR CULVERT REPLACEMENT IN HANOVER

Drivers should follow posted detour route


HANOVER – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will close a section of Beatties Mill Road (Route 634) in Hanover County beginning Monday, August 3 for culvert replacement work. Weather permitting, work is expected to be complete in **mid-November 2020**.

The road will be closed from Mechanicsville Turnpike (Route 360) to Sandy Valley Road (Route 635).

During work, the following detour route will be in place:

From Mechanicsville Tnpk. (Rt. 360) – Take Little Florida Rd. (Rt. 650) south to Sandy Valley Rd. (Rt. 635) east to Beatties Mill Rd.

From Beatties Mill Rd. to Mechanicsville Tnpk. (Route 360) – Take Sandy Valley Rd. (Rt. 635) west to Little Florida Rd. (Rt. 650) north to Mechanicsville Tnpk.



Local traffic will be able to access property throughout the project.
