

Hampton/Poquoson

Wythe Creek Road Widening

Cost: \$50 Million

Current Status: In design. Advertisement scheduled for Fall 2019. Construction estimated to begin Spring 2020.

About the Project: The purpose of this project is to widen Wythe Creek Road to accommodate future traffic volumes and to raise the existing causeway elevation for emergency egress. The Hampton portion of the project includes widening Wythe Creek Road to three lanes, curb and gutter installation, and a 10-foot sidewalk to the east of the expanded roadway. This project also includes widening the causeway and bridge over Wythe Creek. In Poquoson, Wythe Creek Road will be widened to three lanes and include curb and gutter installation, an 8-foot sidewalk to the west of the expanded roadway and a 5-foot sidewalk to the east. This project provides a three-lane reversible roadway, with two lanes being operated in the southbound direction in the AM peak hours, and two lanes in the northbound direction in the PM peak hours. The center lane will operate as a two-way center left-turn lane in the off-peak hours.
