Route 11 Southbound Lane - Cedar Creek Bridge

Estimated Cost:

\$11,112,987

This project will replace the deteriorating southbound lanes bridge over Cedar Creek located on the Shenandoah County/Frederick County line with a two-way, two-lane bridge and remove the existing southbound and northbound bridges. The Route 11 four-lane typical section will revert to a two-lane section upon completion of this project.

Route 600 (Headley Road) - North Fork of Shenandoah River Bridge

Estimated Cost:

\$2,140,903

This project replaces the single-lane low water bridge on Route 600 (Headley Road) over the North Fork of the Shenandoah River. The project limits extend from Route 654 (Zion Church Road) to 0.2 mile east of Route 654.

Estimated Ad Date:

Fall 2016

The new bridge will be a single-lane low water bridge, but will be five feet higher than the current structure. Pull-off areas will be placed at both ends of the bridge, which will allow drivers to wait for bridge traffic to clear. The new bridge will be built upstream of the current bridge location. Minor improvements to the Route 600 and Route 654 intersection will be part of this project.

Route 663 (Artz Road) - North Fork of the Shenandoah River Bridge

The purpose of this project is to replace the Route 663 bridge over the North Fork of the Shenandoah River. The current 16-foot wide bridge is a single-lane low-water structure. The new bridge will be a single lane structure, constructed parallel to the existing bridge. The project also includes rebuilding the approaches in approximately same alignment. The project is located a half-mile from Route 11.

Route 675 (Stony Creek Road) Stony Creek Bridge

Estimated Cost:

\$2,046,447

This project is located on Route 675 (Stoney Creek Road) in Shenandoah County west of the Town of Edinburg, between Interstate 81 and Route 42. The bridge over Stony Creek will be replaced with a new structure. The current bridge was built in 1932 and has reached the end of its service life.

Estimated Ad Date:

Late 2016

The existing bridge is a single lane structure with raised curb and no railing. Route 675 in this location has 10-foot to 11-foot wide lanes with no shoulders. The existing single lane bridge will be replaced with a new, two-lane structure in approximately the same location. The new bridge is approximately 30-feet wide and 105-feet long. Both approaches will consist of two, 11-foot lanes with 3-foot shoulders. This 0.07-mile long project extends from 2.33-miles north of Route 682 to 0.33-mile south of Route 42. The project is a bridge replacement project with roadway improvements to connect to existing roadway, no additional improvements are proposed.

Queen Street Town of Strasburg - Town Run Bridge

The proposed project is located on Queen Street in the Town of Strasburg. The work involves replacing the bridge over Town Run and provides drainage improvements in the area. The project limits extend from 0.088-mile west of South Massanutten Street to 0.044-mile west of South Massanutten Street.
