This approval assumes that FHWA will be administering this project and therefore, responsible for approving the STIP amendment. If FTA will be administering the project, then they will need to approve the STIP amendment. Based on the first assumption, my approval follows.

Information regarding FY 2010 STIP amendment #16, transmitted via e-mail on July 15, 2010, has been reviewed. A copy of the STIP amendment request letter from the Secretary with supporting documentation of MPO coordination was included with the e-mail. The amendment involves one FHWA-administered project (UPC #s T9879). The project will not be jointly administered by FHWA and FTA.

Although the project is located in an air quality nonattainment area, the amendment involves a project that is considered air quality neutral and will not affect the air quality conformity analysis. The documentation demonstrates that the affected MPO has taken appropriate action to address the project in their TIP. Finally, the STIP amendment demonstrates fiscal constraint and will not affect the FHWA/FTA Planning Finding dated September 22, 2008; accordingly, the planning finding remains valid.

Based on the foregoing, STIP **amendment FY10-16** for the FHWA-administered project is approved today, July 15, 2010.
