

## Alternate Fix for Relative Links in Adobe Reader (11.0.11)

### Disclaimer

You must have Administrative Rights to your computer for this to work. This works for Windows 7 running Acrobat XI Reader with the May 2015 security update installed

To create a registry batch file for Adobe XI versions of Reader 32/64 bits:

Open Notepad : (Go to START → All Programs → Accessories → Click on NOTEPAD)

### **For 32-bit version of Adobe XI copy and paste:**

**;Adobe XI - 32 bit**

### **For 64-bit version of Adobe XI copy and paste:**

**;Adobe XI - 64 bit**

1. Save the Notepad file on your desktop or somewhere on your local computer and name the file **Adobe\_regfix.reg**
2. Double click the Adobe\_regfix.reg file you just created. A message with a warning that you are about to change the registry will popup. Click "YES" to continue.
3. Click "OK" to the message that says, "The keys and values contained in (file) have been successfully added to the registry.
4. Open your web browser and try to access the pdf-to-pdf links like you normally would before the security update.
