


# ProjectWise Job Aid – Bluebeam Revu Integration


## Setting Bluebeam to recognize the ProjectWise Datasource

1. Open Bluebeam Revu, click on “Revu” in the top left corner then “Preferences” or simply press Ctrl +K to bring up the “Preferences” dialog.

2. Select “Interface” then the “File Access” tab.



3. Select “+” to add a new source and a new dialog will open.




4. “Type” input should be “ProjectWise V10” and the Checkout on Open box checked. Select “Load”; Select the arrow down at end of “Datasource\*” input, this will populate your Datasource options. Select your District Caching Server or Central Office Datasource. This depends on your location.

5. Select OK to accept Datasource and OK again to exit.

## Opening a ProjectWise Document in Bluebeam


- I. Click on “File” and select “Open”. ProjectWise should log you in using your windows credentials. You will be looking at the ProjectWise Datasource. Navigate to the PDF you want to open or view.



- II. Check the box in the lower left if you only want to view it as read only.

III. You may still open files on your local disk or network drive by clicking on Open from Disk.



From this dialog, you can navigate anywhere locally or on the network.
