**Transport PES Tips & Tricks**

Here are a few common things to know about entering your estimate correctly.

► Only Regular Bid Item Categories have contingencies.

Description	Contingency Pct
REGULAR BID ITEMS	5
LUMP SUM CONST SURVEYING	0
LUMP SUM CEI	0

► The most Common Overlooked column in the Worksheet is the "Non-Bid Item" Flag. *Here's a tip : move the Non-Bid Item column next to the Category column then be sure there is " Y" for every category 2000 and higher.*

Category Number	Non-Bid Item
3001	Y
2100	Y
0100	N

► The County tab should have only 1 and must equal 100.

County/City/District Code	County Name	Approx. Percent of Project Length
C047	JAMES CITY	100

For projects that are District or State wide use the following for the County. They are located at the end of list in the table.
