

## I-81 southbound single lane closure dates and times:


March 25, 9 p.m. to March 31, 7 a.m.
April 1, 9 p.m. to April 7, 7 a.m.
April 8, 9 p.m. to April 14, 7 a.m.
April 15, 9 p.m. to April 21, 7 a.m.
April 29, 9 p.m. to May 5, 7 a.m.
May 6, 9 p.m. to May 12, 7 a.m.
May 20, 9 p.m. to May 26, 7 a.m.
June 3, 9 p.m. to June 9, 7 a.m.

**Tractor trailers** stay on I-81 southbound.

**Passenger vehicles** use the primary detour.

Traffic volumes peak between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m.

Continue southbound on Rt. 11 approximately 13 miles to Fairfield area turning right onto Rt. 710 and re-entering I-81 southbound exit 200.

### I-81 Southbound - Single Lane Work Zone

This location is south of Staunton near exit 217 at Route 654 (White Hill Road) in the Mint Spring area and exit 213 at Route 11 (Lee Jackson Highway) in the Greenville area.

I-81 southbound will be reduced to one lane in this work zone.

### Primary Detour

The primary detour is for passenger vehicles. Traffic will leave I-81 southbound at exit 217 onto Route 654 (White Hill Road) westbound to Route 11 (Lee Jackson Highway). Motorists will turn left onto Route 11 southbound and re-enter I-81 at exit 213

### Secondary Detour

Traffic leaves I-81 southbound at exit 221 onto I-64 eastbound. Motorists will exit I-64 at exit 94 onto Route 340 (Stuarts Draft Highway) near Ladd, which is just west of Waynesboro. Motorists will head south on Route 340 to Route 11 (Lee Jackson Highway), turning left onto Route 11 southbound and travel down to the Fairfield area turning right onto Route 710 (Sterrett Road) and re-entering I-81 southbound at exit 200.

## Estimated Travel Times

I-81	3-5 min.	5-15 min.	45-90 min.
Primary Detour	4-6 min.	10-20 min.	45-90 min.
Secondary Detour	40 min.	40 min.	40-50 min.

**Tractor trailers** stay on I-81 southbound. **Passenger vehicles** use the primary detour.
