



Saving your Adopt-a-Highway Adopted Segments File: Interactive Map

Please note: The Upload dates next to the Zip file and resave your file regularly as changes will be posted at regular intervals.


Move your Mouse over the file you wish to select
Right Click on the file you wish to Save and select **'SAVE TARGET AS'**



You can then select where you would like to save the Zip File
You do this by clicking on the drop down menu selection next to the Save in and your options will be shown as displayed below:




Once you have navigated to the folder of your choice:
Click on the **'SAVE'** Button




It is suggested that you create an Adopt-a-Highway Folder on your local drive to store this information for ease of later retrieval.

Opening your Zip File to Display the Interactive Map using Google Earth:


Navigate to where you saved your Zip file from the VDOT website




Click to highlight your selected file




Double Click on the file to Open WINZIP
