
Committee's Top Technical concerns

- **Creating and improving long distance routes**
 - Birthplace of America Trail Study in Hampton Roads
 - Appomattox Trail connection to Capital Trail
- **Maintenance Payments / funding loss from road diets**
 - Urban Manual will be updated in Fall
 - Need to submit certification from P.E. when Urban Mileage updates due around February
- **Sweeping Bike Lanes / snow clearing**
 - Maintenance discussions underway
- **Urban Standards / Urban Retrofits / DRPT Multimodal Design Guidelines and NACTO**
 - Road Design Manual Updated
 - FHWA Interim Approvals
 - 1974 VDOT Bikeways Design guide
- **2004 CTB Policy documents**
 - Project tracking underway
