NORTHERN VIRGINIA REGIONAL COMMISSION

The Northern Virginia Regional Commission (NVRC) serves the counties of Arlington, Fairfax, Loudoun, and Prince William; the cities of Alexandria, Fairfax, Falls Church, Manassas, and Manassas Park; and the towns of Dumfries, Herndon, Leesburg, Purcellville, and Vienna. The National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) at the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG) is the federally-designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Washington metropolitan area. In addition to the District of Columbia and areas in Maryland, the MWCOG includes all of the Northern Virginia member jurisdictions. A separate Regional Long Range Transportation Plan is not being developed for this region because:

- 1) All of the Northern Virginia region is included in the Washington metropolitan area meaning that there are no areas defined as rural within NVRC.
- 2) Transportation planning needs and requirements for the Northern Virginia region are addressed in the National Capital Region's Financially Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan.
