



ADDS CAPACITY ON I-95

The new Express Lanes will provide 66% more capacity during peak periods and will move 30% more people and 23% more vehicles compared to today's condition.¹



IMPROVES TRAVEL ON THE REGULAR LANES

Fred Ex will reduce congestion in the region, providing time savings to the regular lanes. The 95 Express Lanes have reduced travel times on the regular lanes by 14%.²



CREATES JOBS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Construction of the project estimated to create over 9,000 jobs and generate over \$1 billion in economic activity.



SEAMLESS CUSTOMER EXPERIENCE

Fred Ex will operate with the future 395 Express Lanes as a single, fully-integrated 95 Express Lanes facility between the Potomac and Rappahannock Rivers.

NEW HOV AND TRANSIT OPTIONS

The project will create an additional 10 miles of new HOV and transit options improving travel times for carpoolers, sluggers, and bus riders.



PROVIDES FUNDING FOR ADDITIONAL CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS


Transurban will provide \$277 million to the Commonwealth to fund critical transportation projects in the corridor, such as the northbound Rappahannock River Crossing Project.



ENHANCES QUANTICO ACCESS

Two new flyover ramps will provide faster and easier access for more than 28,000 people working in Quantico and at the Quantico Marine Base. The project will also create several other new access points, providing new travel options for drivers.

Whether you're traveling the I-95 corridor as part of your commute or headed to the beach for vacation, the 95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension will get you there faster and safer. The project, known simply as Fred Ex, is scheduled to open in 2022 and will extend the 95 Express Lanes another 10 miles south to right near Fredericksburg.



Fred Ex will pick up where the 95 Express Lanes currently end, just past Route 610 in Stafford County, and extend to near Route 17. When Fred Ex is wrapped up, it will join the existing network, creating an uninterrupted Express Lanes corridor between the Potomac and Rappahannock Rivers.
