Find out about the proposed improvements to the Route 675, Tola Road Bridge over Cub Creek and the approaches. The project begins 0.123 miles west of Cub Creek and ends 0.121 miles east of Cub Creek. The road will be closed during construction and a signed detour will be provided.

Review the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or at VDOT's Lynchburg District Office located at 4219 Campbell Avenue in Lynchburg, 434-947-6559 or TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of personnel to answer your questions.

Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places are included in the National Environmental Policy Act documentation.
