



Route 11 (Lee Highway) Botetourt County Bridge Replacement Project

Find out about the proposed plans to replace the Route 11 bridge over Firestone Creek in Botetourt County. The project will involve replacing the functionally obsolete and structurally deficient bridge.

Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Dan Collins, Salem Residency Administrator, Virginia Department of Transportation, 714 South Broad Street, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to **November 18, 2009**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is provided in the environmental documentation.
