



Change in Limited Access Control Route 37 in Frederick County

VDOT invites you to review information about a proposed change in limited access on the west side of Rt.37 at the Medical Campus Boulevard Interchange. The 1,570 foot shift in the line will expand the right of way on the west side of the interchange to allow for road construction and an access break requested by Valley Health Systems. This break will be for the exclusive use of Winchester Medical Center property located southwest and adjacent to Rt. 37 and the Medical Campus Boulevard Interchange.
