VDOT HOT SPOTS FOR THE FREDERICKSBURG REGION *April 5 – April 11, 2015*

Stafford County

Interstate 95 South

(New) On Tuesday at midnight there will be a brief closure of all lanes on I-95 south at mile marker 131.5 located just north of Exit 130 (Rt. 3/Fredericksburg). All traffic will be stopped for approximately 15 minutes. Crews will be transporting a large crane from the right shoulder to the median. Virginia State Police will assist with traffic control during the closure.

Interstate 95 at Truslow Road Overpass

(New) On Tuesday and Wednesday lane closures are planned on I-95 northbound and I-95 southbound at the Truslow Road overpass, located between Exit 133/Falmouth and Exit 136/Centreport Parkway, for bridge work. Lanes will be closed according to the following schedule:

- **7 p.m. to 10 p.m.** – Single lane of I-95 northbound and southbound closed
- **10 p.m. to 4 a.m.** – Two lanes of I-95 northbound and southbound closed

Blue and Gray Parkway (Eastbound Route 3)

(New) **Monday**, 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.; motorists will be restricted to one lane on the eastbound side of the Blue and Gray Parkway for bridge joint repair.

Route 3 Business (Kings Highway)

(New) **Tuesday – Friday**, 8 p.m. – 4 a.m.; crews will be milling and paving on the westbound side of Route 3 (Kings Highway) from the Blue and Gray Parkway to the railroad overpass located just west of Cool Springs Road. Motorists will be restricted to one lane in the work zone.

Falmouth Intersection

(New) On Saturday, April 11 from 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. traffic will be reduced to one lane on intersection approaches at Route 1 northbound, Route 1 southbound, and westbound Butler Road. Westbound Route 17 Business traffic reduced to one lane west of the intersection. Utility work will be underway in connection with the Falmouth intersection improvement project.

Traffic Signal Inspections

(New) Wednesday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.; crews will be performing traffic signal safety inspections at various intersections. Motorists should expect lane closures and brief delays at the following locations:

Hunter's Trail

Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; Crews will be milling and paving on various streets in the Hunter's Trail subdivision. Motorists should expect brief delays, a rough driving surface and be alert to construction crew and equipment in the area.

Stone Hill

Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; Crews will be milling and paving on various streets in the Stone Hill subdivision. Motorists should expect brief delays, a rough driving surface and be alert to construction crews and equipment in the area.

Settler's Landing

Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; Crews will be milling and paving on various streets in the Settler's Landing subdivision. Motorists should expect brief delays, a rough driving surface and be alert to construction crews and equipment in the area.

Routine Maintenance Activities

(Update) Monday - Friday, midnight – 8 a.m. crews will be performing routine maintenance that may cause brief travel delays at the following locations:

Deacon Road – sweeping

Cool Spring Road – sweeping

Chatham Heights Road – sweeping from Route 3 to Route 218

Butler Road – sweeping from Route 1 to Cool Springs Road

Blue and Gray Parkway – sweeping from the Fredericksburg City limits to Route 3

Route 17 – sweeping from Route 1 to the I-95 overpass.

Route 1 – sweeping from the Fredericksburg City limits to Route 17 at Falmouth

Spotsylvania County

Route 2/17 Business

(New) Tuesday – Friday, 8 p.m. – 6 a.m.; crews will be milling and paving on Route 2/17 Business between Powell Street and the Fredericksburg City limits. Expect delays.

Leavells Road

(New) Tuesday-Wednesday, 7 p.m. to 11 a.m. northbound Leavells Road, and 7 p.m. to 10 a.m. on southbound Leavells Road. Paving and striping work for intersection improvement project. Periodic lane closures.

Falcon Drive

(Update) Tuesday - Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; crews will be paving on Falcon Drive between Mine Road and the cul-de-sac. Expect brief delays.

Market Street

(Update) Tuesday - Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; crews will be paving on Market Street between Route 1 and Spotsylvania Avenue. Expect brief delays.

Traffic Signal Inspections

(New) Tuesday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. and 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.; crews will be performing traffic signal safety inspections at various intersections. Motorists should expect lane closures and brief delays at the following locations:

- Route 208 – from Robert E. Lee Drive to American Legion Drive (day and night work)
- Route 3 – from Gordon Road to Confederate Cemetery Drive (night work)
- Route 628 at Spotsylvania County Parkway (night work)

Route 17/Benchmark Road/Crossroads Parkway

Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 3 p.m. Motorists should expect lane closures and brief traffic stops on Route 17 at Benchmark Road and Crossroads Parkway, located just east of the CSX railroad tracks and west of Jim Morris Road. Flaggers will direct motorists through the work zone. This work is related to construction of a new Virginia Railway Express station and parking lot. This project is being administered by Spotsylvania County.

Routine Maintenance Activities

City of Fredericksburg

Fall Hill Avenue

Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. Single lane closure. Motorists should expect delays on Fall Hill Avenue between the Rappahannock Canal bridge and the entrance to Crestview Apartments. Traffic will be reduced to one lane, and motorists will be directed through the work zone by a flagging crew. Crews are removing trees along Fall Hill Avenue as part of a road widening project. Single lane closures will continue on weekdays at this location for the next few weeks.

Caroline County

Routine Maintenance Activities

Under Construction

Spotsylvania County

Leavells Road at Harrison Road

The median and turn lane improvement project at the Route 639 (Leavells Road) and Route 620 (Harrison Road) intersection is underway. Motorists should be prepared for lane closures, construction activity and temporary traffic patterns through April 2015, when the project will be completed.

Loriella Park Drive

The road is currently closed with a detour in place. The fixed completion date for this project is April 25, 2015.

Plantation Forest Drive

Construction will continue with single-lane closures through April 2015.

Stafford County

Route 17

Construction is underway to widen Route 17 from four to six lanes between McLane Drive and Stafford Lakes Parkway, a distance of nearly 2 miles. The work zone extends from just south of the I-95 interchange to Cardinal Forest Drive. Motorists should be alert to changes in traffic pattern and periodic overnight lane closures. Project completion date is December 2016.

Falmouth Intersection (Route 1/Route 17 Business/Route 218)

Construction is underway. Motorists should be prepared for brief delays and periodic lane closures on Butler Road and Route 1 just north and south of the Falmouth intersection. Project completion date is September 2015.

King George

Route 218 @ Machodoc Creek

Construction is underway on the Machodoc Creek bridge replacement project. Traffic on the bridge has been reduced to one lane. Temporary traffic signals at each approach to the bridge control traffic crossing the bridge. The signals will remain in place through July 2015. Motorists can expect an additional 5-10 minutes to cross the bridge during peak travel times on weekday mornings and afternoons. In addition, a 10 foot lane width restriction for vehicles is in place.
