VDOT HOT SPOTS FOR THE FREDERICKSBURG REGION *June 7 – June 13, 2015*

Stafford County

Falmouth Intersection Improvement Project

(Update) Motorists should expect the following lane closures this week in connection with the Falmouth intersection improvement project. Flaggers and/or electronic signs will direct motorists through the work zone:

- **Route 1 South**
Monday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.; both existing lanes on Route 1 south, just north and south of the intersection, will be shifted to the right onto the newly constructed southbound lanes. The existing turning and through traffic movements will remain in place from the new lanes. The Route 218 traffic shift has been postponed until Sunday, June 14.
- **Route 218 (Butler Road)**
Sunday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.; westbound motorists will be restricted to one lane in the vicinity of Route 1. Crews will be paving in this area.

Tuesday and Wednesday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.; westbound motorists will be restricted to one lane in the vicinity of Route 1. Crews will be paving in this area.
- **Route 17**
Sunday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.; westbound motorists will be restricted to one lane in the vicinity of Route 1. Crews will be paving in this area.

Route 628 (Eskimo Hill Road)

(New) On Wednesday at 7 p.m. Route 628 (Eskimo Hill Road) will be closed to traffic overnight for a drainage pipe replacement project. Eskimo Hill Road will be closed between State Shop Road and Southern View Drive. The recommended detour routes are Route 1, Layhill Road, Primmer House Road, Leeland Road and Potomac Run Road. The road will re-open to traffic by 6 a.m. on Thursday.

Spotsylvania County

Interstate 95 North

Sunday – Thursday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.; milling and paving work continues on I-95 north between Exit 126 (Route 1/Spotsylvania) and Exit 130 (Route 3/Fredericksburg). Motorists should expect single or double lane closures and travel delays in the work zone.

Holleybrooke Subdivision

(Update) Monday - Wednesday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; crews will continue milling and paving on various streets located in the Holleybrooke subdivision. Motorists should expect brief delays and a rough driving surface in the work zone.

Fox Point Subdivision

(Update) Wednesday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; crews will be milling and paving on various streets located in the Fox Point subdivision. Motorists should expect brief delays and a rough driving surface in the work zone.

Route 627 (Gordon Road)

(New) Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.; motorists travelling north on Gordon Road will be restricted to one lane from Route 620 (Harrison Road) to Route 3 (Plank Road). Crews will be trenching in this area.

King George County

Route 218

Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.; motorists should expect brief delays on the eastbound side of Route 218 between Route 651 (Valley Hill Loop) and Passapatanzy Drive. Crews are trimming trees in this area. Flaggers will direct traffic in the work zone.

(Update) Monday - Friday, 6 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Crews will be performing routine maintenance that may cause brief travel delays at the following locations:

- **Route 218 (Caledon Road)** – mowing

Under Construction

Fredericksburg

Fall Hill Avenue Widening and I-95 Overpass Replacement Project

Construction is underway on the Fall Hill Avenue widening and I-95 overpass replacement project. Motorists should expect lane closures and brief delays on Fall Hill Avenue between the Rappahannock Canal Bridge and Carl D. Silver Boulevard. The project is expected to be complete in January 2017.

Spotsylvania County

Route 17/Benchmark Road/Crossroads Parkway

Motorists should expect lane closures and brief traffic stops on Route 17 at Benchmark Road and Crossroads Parkway, located just east of the CSX railroad tracks and west of Jim Morris Road. Flaggers will direct motorists through the work zone. This work is related to construction of a new Virginia Railway Express train station and parking lot. This project is being administered by Spotsylvania County.

Stafford County

Route 17

Construction is underway to widen Route 17 from four to six lanes between McLane Drive and Stafford Lakes Parkway, a distance of nearly 2 miles. The work zone extends from just south of the I-95 interchange to Cardinal Forest Drive. Motorists should be alert to changes in traffic pattern and periodic overnight lane closures. Project completion date is December 2016.

Falmouth Intersection (Route 1/Route 17 Business/Route 218)

Construction is underway. Motorists should be prepared for brief delays and periodic lane closures on Butler Road and Route 1 just north and south of the Falmouth intersection. Project completion date is September 2015.

King George

Route 218 at Machodoc Creek

Construction is underway on the Machodoc Creek bridge replacement project. Traffic on the bridge has been reduced to one lane. Temporary traffic signals at each approach to the bridge control traffic crossing the bridge. The signals will remain in place through July 2015. Motorists can expect an additional 5-10 minutes to cross the bridge during peak travel times on weekday mornings and afternoons. In addition, a 10 foot lane width restriction for vehicles is in place.
