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Hot Spots for the Fredericksburg Region *May 11 – May 17, 2014*

Stafford County

Interstate 95

(New) Monday and Thursday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.; one lane will be closed periodically on I-95 north and south between Exit 143 (Rt. 610/Garrisonville) and mile marker 156 in Prince William County. Crews will be repairing potholes in this area. Motorists should expect delays in this mobile work zone.

Interstate 95

(New) Sunday - Monday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.; motorists should expect delays on I-95 south at the bridge over Potomac Creek located north of Exit 136 (Centreport Parkway). Crews will be performing routine bridge repairs. One lane will be closed in the work zone.

Interstate 95

(New) Tuesday - Wednesday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.; motorists should expect delays on I-95 north at the bridge over Potomac Creek located north of Exit 136 (Centreport Parkway). Crews will be performing routine bridge repairs. One lane will be closed in the work zone.

Spotsylvania County

Route 608 (West Catharpin Road)

(Update) Monday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; crews will continue milling and paving on Route 608 (West Catharpin Rd.) between the Orange County line and Route 612 (Catharpin Road) at the east overlap. Flaggers will direct motorists through the work zone.

Route 622 (Fairview Road)

(Update) Monday - Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; crews will be paving on Route 622 between Route 601 (Lewiston Road) and Route 738 (Partlow Road). Flaggers will direct motorists through the work zone.

Route 620 (Spotswood Furnace Road)

(New) Starting Monday, May 12, new bridge construction will begin on Route 620 (Spotswood Furnace Road) in Spotsylvania County at Laroque Run and Pipe Dam Run. Spotswood Furnace Road will be closed between River Road and U.S. Ford Road through July 1, 2014. Detour signs have been posted to guide motorists.

Ruffins Pond Subdivision

(Update) The resurfacing project in the Ruffins Pond subdivision will begin on Thursday, May 24. Crews will be working from daylight to dusk through Friday, May 23 at the following locations:

- Route 1369 (Sharon Springs Drive)
- Route 1372 (South Fulton Drive)
- Route 1373 (Pittston Road)
- Route 1374 (New Scotland Drive)
- Route 1509 (Boston Road)

- Route 1549 (Heriot Row Court)

Caroline County

Interstate 95

(New) Tuesday and Wednesday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.; one lane will be closed on I-95 north between mile marker 106 and mile marker 108 located just north of Exit 104 (Rt. 207/Carmel Church) in Caroline County. Crews will be repairing the pavement in this area. Motorists should expect brief delays.

Route 609

(Update) Thursday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; motorists will be restricted to one lane on Route 609 from Route 606 (Stonewall Jackson Road) to the Spotsylvania County line. Crews are patching in this area.

Route 17 North

(New) Monday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; motorists will be restricted to one lane on Route 17 north between the Town of Tappahannock in Essex County and Port Royal in Caroline County. Crews will be paving in this area.

King George County

Route 206

(Update) Motorists are reminded that Route 206 is closed to traffic from just east of Route 218 (Windsor Drive) to Route 624 (Owens Drive) near the Beechwood Office Center. Crews are working to install a drainage pipe under the roadway. Use Route 218 and Route 301 as a detour route. Route 206 will reopen to traffic by 5 a.m. on Monday, May 12. This work is in connection with the Route 206 Turn Lane Project.

Route 3

(Update) Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.; motorists will be restricted to one lane on the eastbound side of Route 3 from Route 665 to just of Route 694. Crews will be milling and paving in this area.

Route 206

(New) Wednesday – Thursday, 7 p.m. – 5 a.m.; motorists will be restricted to one lane on the westbound side of Route 206 from just east of Rt. 301 to the Dahlgren Navel Base. Crews will be milling up the pavement in this area. Motorists should expect a rough driving surface. Flaggers will direct traffic through the work zone.

Caroline County

Route 639 Widening

Route 639 is being widened, creating a left new left turn lane near the Route 1 intersection. During construction the posted speed limit will be lowered to 35 mph in the work zone. One lane will remain open in each direction during construction. Motorists should be alert to traffic pattern changes in this area. The project completion date is May 2015.

City of Fredericksburg

Fall Hill Avenue

Fall Hill Avenue is closed to all traffic at the Rappahannock Canal bridge through November 2014 for a bridge replacement project. Motorists should use Cowan Boulevard as a detour route.

King George County

Route 206

The intersection of Route 206, Owens Drive and Windsor Drive is being widened to accommodate new left turn lanes and right turn lanes. Single lane closures will be in place weekdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Project completion date is December 2014.

Stafford County

Route 17

Route 17 is being widened from four to six lanes between McLane Drive and Stafford Lakes Parkway, a distance of nearly 2 miles. The work zone extends from just south of the I-95 interchange to International Parkway. Motorists should be alert to changes in the traffic pattern and periodic overnight lane closures. Project completion date is December 2016.

Route 1 Bridge over Aquia Creek

Crews are replacing the Route 1 bridge at Aquia Creek, located just south of Telegraph Road. Motorists should be alert to construction equipment entering and exiting the work zone and periodic lane closures. Estimated completion date is August 2015.

Falmouth Intersection (Route 1/Route 17/Route 218)

Construction is underway. Motorists should be prepared for brief delays and periodic lane closures on Butler Road and Route 1 just north and south of the Falmouth intersection. The project is expected to be complete by fall 2015.
