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VDOT HOT SPOTS IN THE FREDERICKSBURG DISTRICT *Sept. 25 – Oct. 1, 2016*

I-95 Mobile Work Zones (Stafford County to Caroline County)

(New) Sunday – Thursday, 8 p.m. – 4 a.m. Crews will refresh the pavement markings on I-95 northbound and southbound. Work will begin on I-95 southbound at the Stafford County line and move southward to the Hanover County line and then continue on I-95 northbound beginning at the Caroline County line and move northward to the Prince William County line. Re-striping may take place on various on and off ramps along the corridor. Motorists should be alert to slow moving trucks and expect brief delays in the mobile work zone.

District-wide Bridge Washing

(Update) Sunday – Thursday, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. Bridge washing will take place at the following locations this week. Motorists should expect intermittent single lane closures and brief delays during the overnight hours for these mobile work zones. Each bridge takes approximately two hours to wash.

Gloucester

Stafford County

Route 17

(Update) Monday – Thursday, 7 a.m. – 3 p.m. Motorists should expect intermittent turn lane closures on Route 17 northbound and southbound between McLane Drive and Stafford Lakes Parkway for traffic signal work.

Route 609 (Raven Road)

(New) On Monday Route 609 (Raven Road) will be closed to through traffic for a bridge replacement project over Accokeek Creek. Raven Road will be closed near the eastern intersection with Route 608 (Brooke Road). Traffic will be detoured around the bridge project for an estimated four weeks, weather permitting. Motorists should follow posted detour signs along Raven Road and Brooke Road.

Route 610 (Garrisonville Road)

(Update) Sunday – Thursday. One lane will be closed intermittently on Route 610 eastbound and westbound at Onville Road from daylight to dusk and again from 8 p.m. – 5 a.m. in this work zone. Crews are placing sewer lines for the Route 610/Onville Road intersection improvement project.

City of Fredericksburg

Interstate 95

(New) This week crews will be pouring concrete for the new bridge over I-95 at Fall Hill Avenue. Motorists will be restricted to one lane on I-95 in the work zone located at mile marker 131 on the following days:

- **Sunday** - Two lanes closed on I-95 northbound from 10 p.m. Sunday until 4:30 a.m. Monday morning
- **Monday** – Two lanes closed on I-95 southbound from 9:30 p.m. Monday until 5 a.m. Tuesday morning.

Fall Hill Avenue

(Update) **Monday** – Motorists should be prepared for a slight traffic shift near the entrance to Crestview Apartments. Flaggers will direct traffic through the work zone.

Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. and **Friday**, 9 a.m. – noon. Motorists should expect intermittent lane closures on Fall Hill Avenue between Carl D. Silver Parkway and the Rappahannock Canal for construction activity. Flaggers will direct motorists through the work zone.

Mary Washington Boulevard

Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. and **Friday**, 9 a.m. – noon. Motorists should expect intermittent lane closures on Mary Washington Boulevard between Hospital Drive and Sam Perry Boulevard for construction activity. Flaggers will direct motorists through the work zone.

Princess Anne Street

Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Paving work will continue on Princess Anne Street between Route 1 and Fauquier Street. This is a mobile work zone. Motorists may encounter single lane closures and brief detours in the work zone. Motorists should follow posted signs and direction from flagging crew. This project will be underway through mid-October. Additional work may occur outside the travel lanes on weekdays 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Spotsylvania County

Interstate 95

(New) **Monday and Tuesday**, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Crews will inspect overhead signs on I-95 northbound and southbound between mile marker 117 and Exit 118 (Route 606/Thornburg). There will be a single lane closure in this mobile work zone.

Route 620 (Harrison Road)

Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. and **Friday**, 9 a.m. – noon. Motorists should expect intermittent flagging and single lane closures on Route 620 (Harrison Road). Motorists may periodically encounter brief delays in the overnight hours in this work zone. This work is in connection with the Route 1 and Harrison Road intersection improvement project.

Traffic Signal Safety Inspections

(Update) Wednesday – Friday, 9 p.m. - 5 a.m. Traffic signal structure inspections will continue this week at various intersections throughout the county to include the following areas. Motorists should expect brief delays in the work zone.

- **Route 3** at Andora Drive, Chewing Lane, Salem Church Road, Heatherstone Drive and Spotsylvania Crossing.
- **Route 1** at Olde Greenwich Drive, Harrison Road, Falcon Drive, Southpoint Parkway and Hudgins Road.
- **Route 2/17** at Thornton Rolling Road.

Spotsylvania Avenue at Mine Road

(New) Tuesday, 6:30 p.m. – 6 a.m. Milling will take place at the Spotsylvania Avenue/Mine Road intersection. Motorists should expect brief delays and a rough driving surface.

Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Motorists should be alert to construction crews and equipment working along the median on Spotsylvania Avenue and in the vicinity of the Spotsylvania Avenue/Mine Road intersection. Expect lane closures and brief delays in this work zone.

Route 17

(Update) Monday – Thursday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Paving and line striping will continue on Route 17 northbound and southbound from just north of Route 301 to just south of Route 675 (Hazelwood Lane). Motorists should expect alternating lane closures in the work zone.

Route 301 at Rappahannock River

(New) Friday, 7 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. Motorists should expect a single lane closure on Route 301 northbound and southbound at the bridge over the Rappahannock River for work related to the bridge rehabilitation project. Expect brief delays on the bridge and at the bridge approaches.

King George County

Traffic Signal Safety Inspections

Route 214

(Update) Monday, Oct. 3 – Thursday, Oct. 6, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Crews will continue paving on Route 214 from Route 3 to Route 609. Expect brief delays in the work zone.

Route 621

(Update) Monday, Oct. 3 – Friday, Oct. 7, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Crews will pave, stripe and place shoulder stone on Route 621 from Route 711 (Bushfield Road) to Route 626 (Mt. Holly Road). Expect brief delays in the work zone.

Northumberland County

Route 644

(Update) Thursday – Friday and Monday, Oct. 3 – Thursday, Oct. 6, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Crews will continue paving, line striping and placing shoulder stone on Route 644 from Route 645 (Gonyon Road) to Route 360. Expect delays in the work zone.

King William County

Route 30 Paving

(Update) Crews will continue paving on Route 30 at the following locations for the next two weeks. Expect delays in the work zone from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

- **Monday – Tuesday**
From Route 632 (Mt. Olive Cohoke Road) to Route 635 (Romancoke Road).
- **Wednesday - Saturday and Monday, Oct. 3**
From Route 631 (Marl Hill Road) to Route 632 (Mt. Olive Cohoke Road).
- **Tuesday, Oct. 3 – Friday, Oct. 7**
From Route 641 (Sandy Point Road) to Route 631 (Marl Hill Road).

Mathews County

Route 14

(Update) **Thursday - Friday and Monday, Oct. 3, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.** Crews will continue paving on Route 14 from Route 611 (Tabernacle Road) to just east of Route 729 (Weston Hall Road). Expect brief delays in the work zone.

Route 198

(Update) **Tuesday – Friday and Monday, Oct. 3, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.** Crews will continue paving on Route 198 from just east of Route 1015 (Cross Street) to the beginning of Route 633 (Fitchetts Wharf Road). Expect brief delays in the work zone.

Highway Improvement Projects

City of Fredericksburg

Fall Hill Avenue Widening and I-95 Overpass Replacement Project

Construction is underway on the Fall Hill Avenue widening and I-95 overpass replacement project. Motorists should expect lane closures and brief delays on Fall Hill Avenue between the Rappahannock Canal bridge and Carl D. Silver Parkway (Central Park), as well as on Mary Washington Boulevard. Project completion is January 2017.

Stafford County

95 Express Lanes Southern Terminus Extension

Construction is underway to extend 95 Express Lanes in Stafford County. The approximate [2.5 mile extension](#) will carry traffic beyond the flyover ramp where 95 Express Lanes currently end, just north of Exit 143/Route 610 (Garrisonville Road). The new southbound exit ramp is scheduled to open by early 2018, and the northbound entrance ramp will open in summer 2018.

Route 610/Onville Road Intersection Improvement Project

Construction is underway at the intersection of Route 610 (Garrisonville Road) and Route 641 (Onville Road) to build additional turn lanes. Traffic has been reduced to one lane in each direction on Onville Road. Project completion is May 2017.

Route 1 and Garrisonville Road Turn Lane Project

Stafford County is locally administering a project to add a second right turn lane from Route 1 southbound to westbound Route 610 (Garrisonville Road). New traffic signal equipment will also be installed at the intersection. Drivers may encounter lane closures during off-peak and overnight hours. Project completion is September 2016.

Spotsylvania County

Spotsylvania Avenue and Mine Road Intersection Improvement Project

Construction is underway at the intersection of Spotsylvania Avenue and Mine Road for an intersection improvement project. Crews will be adding turn lanes, adjusting the existing traffic signal and renovating the sidewalk and median on Spotsylvania Avenue. Motorists should expect brief delays during daytime hours. Extended lane closures will take place during overnight hours. Motorists should expect periodic delays on Mine Road at the intersection. Project completion is mid-November 2016.

Route 1 and Route 620 (Harrison Road)

Construction to build additional turn lanes and extend existing turn lanes is underway at the intersection of Route 1 and Harrison Road in Spotsylvania County. Motorists should be alert for construction crews and equipment. Project completion is May 2018.

Route 628 (Smith Station Road) - *Project Complete*

Construction is now complete on the Route 628 (Smith Station Road) turn lane and signal modification project. The project was located on Smith Station Road near the Route 208 (Courthouse Road) intersection.

Caroline County/King George County

Route 301 at Rappahannock River

Bridge rehabilitation is underway on the James Madison Memorial Bridge over the Rappahannock River. Maintenance will occur below the bridge deck and includes repairing concrete, replacing bearings, shoring up rip-rap on the slope, and replacing navigation lights. All lanes are currently open on the bridge, but single lane will be in place periodically. Project completion is October 2017.

Caroline County/King and Queen County

Route 721 (Newtown Road)

Construction is underway on a new bridge over Beverly Creek in King and Queen County near the Caroline County line. Motorists should be alert to construction crews and equipment in this area. The project is expected to be complete in July 2017.
