

**I-66 Traffic Detour
for Ramp 43A
Demolition of Existing Structure
over I-66 Westbound Ramp to Southbound Route 29**

Wednesday March 12th, 2008 – I-66 Westbound Traffic using Southbound Exit 43A to Route 29 will be closed.

On Wednesday March 12th, 2008 from 7 am to 2 pm, ramp 43A southbound to route 29 from westbound I-66 will be closed to allow the I-66 project to demolish portions of the existing structure over the ramp.

This detour will allow for the removal of the steel girders of the deck over the ramp for I-66 westbound 43A and allow this work to proceed safely for the traveling public as well as the workers.

The interstate traffic will be asked to use exit 43B to northbound Rte 29. To access southbound Rte. 29 bear left on the ramp. At the light they will be able to turn left onto southbound Rte. 29.

Route 29 northbound traffic will not be affected going north onto 29 or I-66 east or west bound.

Since the ramp will be closed there are two options for traffic heading to southbound route 29 from I-66 westbound:

- Option 1: Use exit 43B bear left on ramp, at traffic light turn left onto southbound 29.
- Option 2: Use exit 43B on ramp bear right to north 29, right onto University Boulevard Bridge, right onto Wellington Road, right onto Linton Hall Road, left onto Route 29 South.
