## **ROUTE 258 PAVING PROJECT BEGINS**

*Motorists should expect delays traveling near the Isle of Wight Courthouse Complex*

WAVERLY— The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will begin to repave a one lane mile section of Route 258 between Route 644 and Route 1201 South starting Wednesday, June 17, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Motorists should plan ahead and allow for additional delays while traveling through the area, which includes the Isle of Wight County Courthouse Complex.

This work is a part of a larger maintenance paving overlay contract for Isle for Wight County. Routes covered in this contract include portions of Route 258, Route 10 (Smithfield Bypass), Route 620, Route 669 and Route 58 business in Carrsville. The \$1.215 million contract was awarded to Basic Construction of Newport News. Contract completion is scheduled for December 1, 2009.

Motorists are advised to use caution and follow the posted speed limit while traveling through the work zone.
