**Find out** about proposed sidewalk and intersection improvements on N. Parham Road from Homeview Drive to Skipwith Road in Henrico County.

Proposed plans include adding a sidewalk on N. Parham Road from Homeview Drive to Skipwith Road. Other proposed improvements include installing a traffic signal at the intersection of N. Parham Road and Homeview Drive, replacing a traffic signal mast arm at the intersection of N. Parham Road and Skipwith Road, and building a new right turn lane from N. Parham Road onto Skipwith Road.

**Come see** the proposed plans for traffic signal and sidewalk improvements. The hearing will be held in an open house format. VDOT representatives will be available to answer questions between 5:30-7 p.m.
